This paper documents: a) higher nesting success for Golden-winged Warblers in swamps without Blue-winged Warblers than in uplands with BWWA, b) extensive use of native vegetation and avoidance of non-native plants, and c) major errors in the National Land Bird Conservation Plan by Partners in Flight
