INCORPORATING SUSTAINABILITY INTO THE CURRICULUM SUMMER GRANTS PROJECT PROPOSAL PROCEDURE

The IC-EVI (Ithaca College-EcoVillage at Ithaca) Partnership for Sustainability provides funding for \$1,000 grants during summer 2007 to assist faculty in curricular development consistent with the partnership's larger goals of supporting the teaching of sustainability across the curriculum. The following are the procedures for applying for these competitive grants, including the Proposal Form.

Project Proposals will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

1. The project's potential impact on classroom teaching/learning;
2. The project's relevance to the development of sustainability curricula;
3. The feasibility of the proposed project (explain the likelihood of its successful implementation as well as its value to the overall grant).

Procedures for Submitting a Proposal:

1. Two (2) copies of the proposal are to be submitted in hard copy using the attached proposal form. (Maximum: 2 pages)
2. The proposals should be accompanied by an evaluative statement from your chair attesting to the degree of relevance of the project to departmental needs, and an indication as to whether the proposed course or course revision would be acceptable to the department and could be included in the curriculum.
3. When the project has direct implications for existing or new courses, proposals should include a syllabus (revised or new) specifying the impact the project will have on the conduct of the course.
4. Attach a copy of your curriculum vita, which includes a listing of courses you have taught which have relevance to the proposal.
5. Decisions for funding will be communicated within one week after the deadline for submitting proposals.
