Ithaca College students registering for independent studies, internships, certain workshops, or performance studies, as well as incoming and extramural students, must register in the summer sessions office, Towers Concourse.

Registering by Mail or Fax

Students registering by mail may pay by check or money order. Make your check or money order payable to Ithaca College.

Special Notes

- Continuing Ithaca College degree students should register online for their summer courses using Homer prior to making payment. These students will be billed by the bursar's office for summer charges. Payment is expected prior to the beginning of classes. (Charges will be reflected on the student information system.) Past-due balances must be paid in order to register.
- The summer housing office opens May 15. If you have questions about accommodations, contact the housing staff at 607-274-1637. If you have questions before May 15, contact the Office of Conference and Event Services at 607-274-3313.
- Extramural students wishing to register for undergraduate courses in the School of Business must have the approval of the associate dean. Extramural students registering for graduate-level courses must have the approval of the department's graduate program chair.
