RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students in the Summer College for High School Students must observe College policies as set forth below and in other College publications. Students who violate these rules and/or who behave in an unsafe or reckless manner while on or off College property will be held responsible for their actions.

A violation of any of the following rules and regulations may be the cause for disciplinary action, including possible immediate dismissal from the program without a refund.

- Possession and/or use of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited. *We follow a zero tolerance policy and strictly enforce this policy. Students who are found responsible for an alcohol or drug violation will be immediately dismissed from the program without a refund.*
- Any action or situation involving verbal, mental, or physical assault and/or abuse, including harassment, intimidation, or other conduct that recklessly or intentionally endangers or threatens the health, safety, or welfare of any person is prohibited. Intentional damage to other students' and/or College property is prohibited.
- Students must be in their residence hall by building curfew: 11:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday, and 12:00 a.m. on weekend nights. Residence halls will be locked at all times. The residence halls are open to students in the summer college program and their registered overnight guests. Other visitors must be escorted by summer college participants and must leave the building at curfew or at the request of a summer college residential staff member or other College official.
- Quiet hours must be observed from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. On weekends, quiet hours begin at 1:00 a.m. Disruptive, excessively noisy or indecent conduct is cause for disciplinary action.
- Co-educational (male/female) visitation within a residence hall other than in common areas (lounge, study room, and balconies) is prohibited from two hours after building curfew until 7:00 a.m. the next morning. However, co-educational visitation in a residence hall room requires an open door.
- A student may have an occasional same-sex overnight guest on Friday and Saturday nights only. An overnight guest form, including the roommate's permission, must be submitted to the summer college residential coordinator by 4:00 p.m. on the Thursday preceding the arrival of the guest. The summer college student is responsible for the conduct of his/her guest while they are on campus.
- Students are required to check-in each day at building curfew. Students are required to be on time for all required program activities and to follow the attendance policies of their professors. During non-academic portions of the day, students are expected to be on campus or properly signed out.
- The possession or use of firearms, weapons, fireworks, candles, and incense is prohibited. (Candles and incense are fire hazards.) No smoking is allowed in any building on the Ithaca College campus. Students may not have vehicles on campus during the program. Pets are not allowed.

- Students in the program may leave the campus only if their parents have signed the optional off-campus permission form below and they must follow the conditions stated on the form.
- All medications must be stored with the residential program director.
- Additional rules and guidelines may be found in the Ithaca College Student Handbook. Additional policies may be added that are specific to academic requirements, internet use, co-curricular behavior, or residence hall activities.

I have read the guidelines of behavior stated above and understand that I am required to follow these rules and regulations. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations could result in disciplinary action that may include immediate dismissal from the summer college program, loss of academic credit, forfeiture of tuition and fees, and the requirement that a parent or guardian pick me up.
