

## DATA DEFINITIONS

**These definitions refer to the county profile data that follows.**

**Rural:** Rural areas are defined as open country and settlements with fewer than 2,500 people by the U.S. Census Bureau. They are essentially all areas located outside of urbanized areas (area of 50,000 or more people with a core of 1,000 people per square mile and adjoining territory of at least 500 people per square mile) and urban clusters (at least 2,500 but less than 50,000 people with same population density criteria). A “rural population” row in this data refers to how many people in the specified county reside in an officially rural part of the county.

**Householder:** The U.S. Census Bureau defines a householder as the person, or one of the people, in whose name a home is owned, being bought, or rented. If no one fits this description for a home, then any household member, 15 years or older, can be considered the householder on the census. In this dataset, householder refers to a non-family householder, who is an individual who lives alone or only with non-relatives. A family householder would be an individual living with one or more people related to him or her by birth, adoption or marriage.

**Poverty:** The poverty figure is based on the total income of a family or unrelated individual and is compared to the poverty threshold (income cutoff) appropriate for the family size and composition. In this data set, the poverty level figure relates to the total number of 65 to 74 year olds and 75 and over members of the population. Therefore, there may be individuals who live with a family that falls under the poverty level, or live by themselves or other unrelated individuals and are under the poverty level. 2000 poverty thresholds for 65+ single \$8,954; 2 persons \$10,409. **Go-outside-home-disability:** The percent of total population 65 years and older that have going-outside-the-home disabilities. Difficulty going outside the home alone to shop or visit a doctor’s office is considered a going-outside-the-home disability.
