

General Education Requirements (27-39 credits)

The general education program of the School of Humanities and Sciences explores human communities-how they form, the ways in which they function, and how they and the individuals within them express meaning. The faculty of the school believes that students can best become productive contributors to their communities by developing the sensitivities, knowledge, and values needed to sustain the complex, diverse democracy that is modern American society. General education requirements must be completed by the end of the junior year.
