Wireless access is available for all students at the Rochester Center. We hope you came prepared with your laptop computers. In addition there are desktop computers available in the student lounge and group study rooms. There are both wireless and network laser printers available in the student lounge for student use.

- Cafeteria service is available in the refectory on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 11:00 am to 1:30 pm once the CRCDS students start back in September. Good food and reasonable prices!
- Student Mailboxes – Student mailboxes are located in the hallway outside of the Lecture Hall. Messages, memos and personal mail received in the office will be put in the mailboxes. Please remember to check them periodically.
- Copier Cards – A card will be placed in each student’s mailbox. The student copier is located in the student lounge. Copies are \$.05 each and will be charged to your student account at the end of the academic year. Copiers are also available in the UR Medical Center and Libraries.
- Textbooks ordered through the Ithaca College bookstore for the graduate year will be delivered to the Rochester Center and can be picked up after orientation. They are located in the Teaching Labs G-40.
- Student employment opportunities are available at the Rochester Center. There are two to three positions available to assist the faculty, support staff, and students. Applications will be available after orientation in the lower hallway outside of the lecture hall.
- Two to three class representatives need to be selected to be liaisons for the class, attend planning unit meetings and coordinate student activities. This can be voted on by the class.
- Building Access – You will need to carry your UR ID card with you. This card will identify you as an Ithaca College student.
- There are “shared” spaces on campus, these include the refectory, the library and other open areas in Strong Hall. In addition a student lounge and group study rooms are available for use by students.
