

- Users shall respect the rights of owners of adjacent property and shall not trespass on private lands.
- Boundaries of the Robinson Preserve/ICNRR are indicated by signs posted at regular intervals. Additional signs may be posted by ICNL to indicate that certain uses or entering certain areas is prohibited. Users shall observe and abide by all instructions or warnings displayed on such ICNL signs
- Trails on the Preserve are not marked or maintained and may be incomplete. Cutting and marking of trails is expressly prohibited without specific written permission from ICNL
- ICNL protects all natural resources on the properties, including plants, animals, soils, stone and also cultural resources (e.g., stonewalls, foundations). Users shall not disturb, remove, or injure any vegetation, trees, wildlife other than fish, soil, stone or other natural or cultural resources.
- All applicable regulations and laws of the United States, The State of New York , Tompkins County and the Town of Newfield shall be observed at all times by users of the properties. Additional restrictions specified in this permit must also be observed.
- No one shall be on the properties without a valid User Permit issued by ICNL. This User Permit is valid for two years from the date of the endorsement. It is the User's responsibility to renew this permit.

I agree to and shall abide by these rules, regulations, and conditions and further acknowledge that the failure to so abide may result in the immediate revocation of my ICNL User Permit and prosecution to the fullest extent of the law.
