Ithaca College announces the search for a dynamic, visionary leader to serve as its eighth president.

An Ithaca education emphasizes active learning, aesthetic appreciation, global citizenship, collaborative student-faculty research, and development of the whole student extending beyond the classroom. Ithaca College is a private, comprehensive, residential college with an enrollment of approximately 6,200 undergraduate and 500 graduate students who represent 40 states and 70 countries. Its 12:1 student-faculty ratio allows individual attention and strong student-faculty partnerships. The College provides a diversity of educational opportunities generally found only at large universities but in a supportive and personal private college environment. The five schools— Business, Communications, Health Sciences and Human Performance, Humanities and Sciences, and Music, along with the Division of Interdisciplinary and International Studies and Division of Graduate and Professional Studies, offer more than 100 degree programs, from biochemistry to business administration, journalism to jazz, philosophy to physical therapy.

From its founding in 1892 as the Ithaca Conservatory of Music, Ithaca has had a distinctive and distinguished history of interweaving liberal and professional education. A founding member of the Associated New American Colleges (ANAC), the College has long provided liberal arts students with a practical understanding of life and careers, just as it has imbued students pursuing professional degrees with the core values and intellectual framework to pursue learning beyond the scope of their field.
