

## **MUSEUM OF MODERN ART INTERNSHIP**

The internship program is designed to introduce participants to specific areas of the museum profession. Depending on departmental placements, interns gain an understanding of different areas within the Museum. A lecture program complements the departmental training. The lecture series begins with a comprehensive weeklong orientation within the Museum. Field trips are organized to other museums, galleries, and artists' studios in the five boroughs of New York City.

### **Award**

Summer internships are full-time and last for 9 weeks, from June 8 through August 7. They include a \$2,000 stipend. Internships are also available in Fall and Spring.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

- ◆ Be undergraduate juniors, seniors, recent graduates or current graduate students.
- ◆ International students registered as undergraduates are eligible.
