

## **INTERNATIONAL RADIO AND TELEVISION SOCIETY COLLEGE SUMMER FELLOWSHIP**

The College Summer Fellowship Program is made possible by the generosity of communications companies throughout the broadcast industry. It includes a comprehensive one-week orientation, networking, field trips, and an 8-week fellowship at a New York-based corporation. Fellows have worked at all four major networks, at local New York City radio and television stations, at national rep firms, advertising agencies, and cable operations.

### **Award**

There is no cost to the student and the IRTS Foundation will provide air or train fare, housing at a local college dormitory, and a small allowance. Fellows must be available for the entire nine weeks. The 2010 dates have not been announced; in previous years, the dates were June 8-August 7 and May 31-August 1.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

- ◆ Be full-time juniors or seniors at a four-year college.
- ◆ Be students who exhibit a strong interest in electronic media demonstrated by outstanding course work, extensive extracurricular activity and practical experience, although applicants need not be Communications majors.
