Nearly 30 Demonstration Project proposals were submitted, each of which provided an interesting and valuable possibility for the development of the integrative concept at Ithaca. Unfortunately, not all of the proposals could be funded at this time. The review process involved an evaluation by the Deans followed by a final selection made by the President in conjunction with the Provost.

For those proposals that were not selected, in some cases, the proposal may find another venue for implementation, and deans have already noted some possibilities. In other cases, a proposal may be better suited for a long-range implementation than a short two-year pilot program. So, please keep these good ideas and initiatives in a proverbial "safe place", because many of them may be ideal in the future as we develop the (IC)² initiative over the next few years.
