Bedroom Essentials

- Twin Extra Long Sheet Set (Gardens and Circle Double rooms)
- Full Sheet Set (Circle Single rooms)
- Pillow
- Mattress pad/Foam pad (optional)
- Comforter and/or Blanket
- Extra Throw Blanket
- Lamps (Halogen and Octopus-style lamps are prohibited because they pose a fire hazard!)
- Wastebasket

Bath Essentials

- Bath towels
- Bathrobe
- Bath Mat
- Small Wastebasket
- Hand soap
- Toilet paper
- Shower supplies (Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, etc.)
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Shaving supplies
- Contacts/Glasses/Contact solution (if applicable)
- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer

Emergency Preparedness

- Checkbook, bank card, passport, birth certificate, Social Security card, health insurance card
- Prescription medications
- Over-the-counter remedies (For headaches, cold, flu, etc.)
- Flashlights
- Mini-flashlight for your keychain
- Disposable or digital thermometer
- Batteries
- List of emergency contacts
- First aid kit

Cleaning Supplies

- Vacuum (optional; vacuums are available to be checked out at nearby offices)
- Dish Soap
- Dish Towels
- Dishwasher Detergent and Jet Dry (if you have a dishwasher)
- Sponges
- Disinfecting wipes
- Paper towels
- Room deodorizing spray (Candles and incense pose a fire risk and are prohibited)
- Mop
- Laundry supplies (dirty clothes basket, detergent)
- Trash bags
- Toilet Bowl cleaner and brush
- Cleaning products, like Shower cleaner, Glass cleaner, Bleach, and a General Surface Cleaner (buy eco-friendly if possible)

Kitchen Supplies

- Pots & Pans
- Silverware
- Plates and bowls
- Mugs and Glasses
- Knife Set
- Cutting board
- Slotted spoon, spatula, etc.
- Oven mitts
- Bake ware
- Spices
- Small appliances (blender, mixer, coffee maker, etc.)

Cold Weather Preparedness

- Winter coat and accessories
- Snow shovel (if you own a car)
- Ice scraper (If you own a car)
- Boot Tray (To catch all the melting snow from your shoes)
