

HOME PROGRAM HOUSING AGREEMENT

The HOME (Housing Offering Multicultural Experience) Program housing option is designated for international and domestic students committed to expanding their multicultural experiences. The HOME Program is an excellent living option for students interested in learning more about multicultural issues, students preparing to study abroad or students living in the United States for the first time. In addition to sharing a common residential experience, the students living in the program are required to take one of several designated, 3-credit Multicultural Issues courses during their first semester in HOME and attend 6 multicultural programs and one community discussion each subsequent semester in HOME. During those subsequent semesters, 3 of the 6 programs must be completed by 1 week after the end of the academic block. In addition to the academic and programmatic aspects of HOME, students living in Terrace 2 also have the opportunity to remain in the residence halls over academic break periods. Students requesting to reside in the HOME Program building agree to abide by the following standards:

- 1. Academic Requirement** = All students living in HOME are required to take one of several designated, 3-credit Multicultural Issues courses during their first semester in HOME and attend 6 multicultural programs and one community discussion each subsequent semester in HOME. During those subsequent semesters, 3 of the 6 programs must be completed by 1 week after the end of the academic block.
2. The primary responsibility for enforcement of the academic requirements shall rest with Residential Life staff.
- 3. Violations of the HOME Program guidelines will be handled as follows:**

Students who fail to meet the academic requirements set forth in this agreement will be notified and given the opportunity to participate in alternative activities to meet the requirements and remain in the program. If alternative arrangements cannot be made, the student will be reassigned to another residence hall. This could possibly mean a triple or lounge reassignment dependent upon available space.

"I have read, understood, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of this HOME Program Housing Agreement. I understand that this agreement shall remain in effect throughout my residency in the HOME Program building. I may terminate my participation in this agreement by moving to other College housing that is not a quiet study hall. If no other space is available, I agree to abide by this agreement and these guidelines until such time as I can locate and move to another space in other College housing. I understand that violation of this agreement may result in administrative or judicial action which may include a reassignment to other College housing."
