

SUSTAINABLY CONSCIOUS LEARNING COMMUNITY AGREEMENT

The Sustainably Conscious Learning Community was created by students for students interested in issues of environmental and social responsibility. Students requesting to reside in the Sustainably Conscious Learning Community agree to abide by the following standards:

1. All students are required to participate in the opening camping trip over Labor Day Weekend to facilitate community development and goal setting.
2. In the fall semester, first-year students are required to take the First Year Seminar, "Exploring a Global Challenge".
3. In the fall semester, all other residents are required to participate in 1 out of 2 educational outreach programs and then participate in 3 additional academic programs offered on-campus (either facilitated by the program or offered elsewhere on campus).
4. In the spring semester, all residents are required to participate in 1 out of 2 educational outreach programs and then participate in 3 additional academic programs offered on-campus (either facilitated by the program or offered elsewhere on campus. Students must complete 2 of their program requirements prior to Spring Break.
5. Residents will participate in and prepare at least two of the community dinners each semester. Residents are responsible for using safe food handling guidelines when preparing food. Ithaca College assumes no responsibility for illness or injury arising from involvement in this program.
6. Residents will participate in all Town Meetings to discuss community issues. There will be 1 Town Meeting held each month.
7. The primary responsibility for enforcement of the participation requirements shall rest with Residential Life staff.

Violations of the Sustainably Conscious Learning Community guidelines will be handled as follows:

Students who are falling behind in meeting the requirements set forth in this agreement will be notified and ***if, by the end of the fall semester or by spring break of the spring semester, the student has not met the program requirements he/she will be reassigned from the program.*** This could possibly mean a triple or lounge reassignment dependent upon available space.

"I have read, understood, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of this Sustainably Conscious Learning Community Housing Agreement. I understand that this agreement shall remain in effect throughout my residency in the Sustainably Conscious Learning Community. I may terminate my participation in this agreement by moving to other College housing that is not part of the Sustainably Conscious Learning Community. If no other space is available, I agree to abide by this agreement and these guidelines until such time as I can locate and move to another space in other College housing. I understand that violation of this agreement may result in administrative or judicial action which may include a reassignment to other College housing."
