

**ACADEMIC CONTRACT
FIRST YEAR DEFERRED SUSPENSION PROGRAM – SPRING 2019**

Overview of Policy Requirements

I understand that I must fulfill the academic requirements for Final Warning during the spring 2019 semester as follows:

- obtain a semester grade point average of 2.30 or above,
- complete at least 12 credits for letter grades,
- have no more than one grade below “C” and no “Incompletes” or “Fs,” and
- fulfill the obligations set forth in Parts 1- 4 of my Academic Contract.

***Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in automatic academic suspension at the end of the semester.**

Part 1: In order to register for fall 2019, I will need to demonstrate a good faith effort as described below and also show evidence of earning a 2.30 or better in all my spring 2019 courses.

- To demonstrate good faith in meeting Final Warning requirements, I need to do the following during the spring semester:
 - call the H&S Dean’s Office at 607 274 3102 to set up a meeting with Assistant Dean Amy O’Dowd and Jim Riegel, Academic Services Coordinator, in Muller 201, for the first week of the semester to discuss the reasons for my academic difficulties and required interventions for academic success,
 - establish realistic academic goals,
 - meet as requested with my academic adviser,
 - complete all assignments given to me as outlined below

Part 2: Success Strategies

Based on the initial meeting with Dean O’Dowd and Jim Riegel, I will be given a personalized set of assignments and expectations that may include a combination of the following: attendance at Academic Advising Center workshops, tutoring, meeting with a CAPS counselor, attending office hours with one or more of my professors, goal setting assignments, academic journaling, and academic success strategy assignments. I understand that attendance and/or completion of assignments is mandatory.

Part 3: Meetings scheduled with my academic adviser. Please note: you will need to schedule the meetings with your academic adviser, as prompted by Jim Riegel.

Part 4: One-on-One meetings scheduled with Jim Riegel. I agree to meet every other week during the semester. I will keep track of meetings, arrive on time and prepared, and will notify Jim in advance if I am unable to keep my appointment. Please send any communications to hsadvising@ithaca.edu.
