Teaching "Teaching excellence remains at the heart of our institution. Excellent teaching is consistent and sustained. The Committee recognizes that pedagogies vary from discipline to discipline and school to school. Equity and inclusion are considered essential components of teaching excellence, including, but not limited to, antiracist practices, culturally sustaining pedagogies, and universal design."	Nominee's materials demonstrate distinction with some/all of the following:  centering equity and inclusion incorporating tenets of instructional design featuring experiential learning centering sustainability featuring additional points of excellence not listed above.
Scholarship, Creative Activity, Professional Activity "Ithaca College and the Center for Faculty Excellence recognize many forms of excellence regarding scholarly work. The Boyer Model is only one model used to embrace various forms of quality scholarship including but not limited to scholarship of discovery, integration, application, teaching, and artistic endeavor. "Continued professional experience and engagement generates valuable insight and relevance to the classroom.
