- The concern of the requirement aspect of the committees over the Senate position.
 - o Suggested remediation through senate one-on-ones.
 - o One committee 'requirement' and the other is fully chosen at the senator's discretion.
- Suggestion for the bill:
 - o Writing that this is a strong suggestion to join this committee and not a requirement.

- The rationale for putting more senators in SJAS is for a wider range of senate positions to work on accessibility, environmental, and social issues across campus onto this committee.
