

PROCEDURE FOR REGISTERING FOR

Jr. Research: BIOL-30200: Spring 2020

1. Read the project descriptions available on the website page **Faculty Research Labs**. Look at the faculty's full webpages for greater details.
2. Come to meet the professors at the **Research Meet & Greet on Thursday, Oct 24, 4:00 pm**, in the CNS Front Foyer. This is **REQUIRED** *if you do not already have a firm commitment* from a faculty member.
3. Discuss projects that interest you with faculty members. Get specific information about the project, time required, what is expected of you, type of techniques used, and background required.
4. Select 3 topics supervised by 3 different faculty members, ranking them 1 to 3.
5. Have faculty members **sign your form**. (If you have a firm commitment from your top choice, the single signature will suffice.)
6. **Hand in completed form** to the Biology Administrative Assistant (CNS 161) by **no later than 1:00 pm, Thursday, October 31**. **ALL** students wishing to enroll in 302 must submit a form, this is what is processed as your permission into a section.
7. Check the bulletin board outside the Biology Office to see where you have been assigned. **Projects will be assigned and posted on the bulletin board outside the Biology Office Door, CNS 161**, by noon on **Tuesday, November 5**. Fill in the appropriate section number (each faculty member has a different section) when you register for classes.
