

Ithaca College Accessibility Guide

This guide was created to offer information about the accessibility features of the Ithaca College campus for individuals with mobility and hearing impairments. While every attempt has been made to ensure accurate information, ongoing construction and improvement may change accessibility features. Student Accessibility Services

Ithaca College strives to ensure that all qualified students with disabilities are provided reasonable accommodation to access and participate fully in programs and activities. Student Accessibility Services provides accommodation and service to undergraduate and graduate students with visual, hearing, physical, psychiatric, and learning disabilities. We encourage all students who wish to receive special accommodations to contact Student Accessibility Services.

Campus Visits

- We encourage you to meet with a representative from Student Accessibility Services when visiting Ithaca College to answer any question you may have about services and accommodations. Please schedule an appointment before arriving on campus.
- If other services are required (e.g., an interpreter) contacts the Office of Admissions (607-274-3124) before your tour.

Parking

The parking lots closest to each building have one or more accessible spaces. Specific parking information is included in the accessibility guide. All members of the campus community are required to have a campus parking permit. To access accessible spaces a municipally issued handicap parking permit must also be displayed. Please contact Parking Services (607-274-3756) for further information.

Public Transportation

- *Tompkins Consolidated Area Transit (TCAT)*—Public bus transportation is provided to the City of Ithaca and surrounding areas in Tompkins County by TCAT. There are various TCAT bus stops on Ithaca College Campus: Circle Center in Circles, behind East and West Towers in J lot, outside the North entrance to Park School of Communications by O Lot. All buses are kneel and lift equipped. Visit the TCAT website for route, schedule, and fare information: www.tcatbus.com.
- *Gadabout Transportation Services* operates two different types of service.
 - Gadabout is TCAT's operator for ADA Complementary Paratransit. It is a specialized, door-to-door transport service for people who are not able to ride the fixed-route transit system because of a disability. Service runs the same hours and in the same areas as the TCAT bus system. Contact the ADA transit coordinator for an eligibility application at 607-277-9388, X450. There are eligibility requirements.  - Gadabout also operates a transportation service for Tompkins County residents who are aged sixty and older, and/or have disabilities.

Assistive Listening Devices

- Emerson Suites and Park Auditorium are equipped with FM systems.
- The two theaters in Dillingham are equipped with infrared (IR) systems; ask for the devices at the box office.
- Whalen Center for Music is equipped with an FM system.
- Ford Hall in the Whalen Center for Music is equipped with an infrared (IR) system.

Accessibility Criteria

Certain locations on campus have been specified as accessible; however, there may be some inaccessible features of the building or area. For example, most bathrooms have been called accessible but the exterior doors do not have power-assisted doors (PAD). If there are specific questions about the accessibility of a particular building or location on campus, please contact the Student Accessibility Office at 607-274-1005. 20. Job Hall

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- North Side, Near E Lot, PAD. Can access by walking through Textor Hall or from the outside which has all PAD doors.

Elevator

- Located centrally in building, next to Center for Information Technologies. It provides access to all floors.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible bathrooms are located by the elevators in Job Hall (unisex).

Parking

- E lot has 20 spaces.

Water Fountain

- An accessible water fountain is located by Textor Hall.

16. Friends Hall

Accessible Entrance/Exit

- North Side, near flagpole circle, PAD.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Nearest accessible bathrooms are located in Jobs Hall (unisex) and Phillips Hall.

Parking

- E lot has 20 spaces.

Access Phone

- An access phone is located on the first floor of Friends Hall.

Water Fountain

- An accessible water fountain is located on the first floor of Friends Hall.

29. Textor Hall

Accessible Entrance/Exit

- North, near flagpole circle, PAD.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located in Phillips Hall next to the Book Store.

Parking

- E lot has 20 spaces.

AT/ALD

- Textor 101, 102, and 103 have FM systems. Please contact Classroom Technology Services for assistance.

General Information

- PAD located at each of the following classrooms: T101, T102, and T103.

22. Muller Faculty Center**Accessible Entrance/Exit**

- North, near flagpole circle, PAD.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located in Phillips hall next to the Book Store.

Parking

- E lot has 20 spaces.

21. Muller Chapel**Accessible Entrance/Exit**

- North side of building, near pond on ground level.
- East and West entrances on first floor, PAD.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Currently, there are no accessible bathrooms in the chapel.

Hours of Operation

- Open for classes and study from 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.
- Office hours are 8:30 a.m. -- 10:00 p.m.
- For information on services, check the events calendar on the Ithaca College website or call 607 274 3103.

Parking

- E lot has 20 spaces

Water Fountain

- Currently, there are no accessible water fountains

33. Williams Hall**Accessible Entrances/Exits**

- First floor west (PAD)
- First floor east, main entrance (PAD)

Elevator

- Located centrally in building, it provides access to all floors, by east entrance

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible bathrooms located on first, second, and third floors

Parking

- Accessible parking spaces are located in E lot (west side) with 20 spaces and U lot (east side) with 11 spaces

Access Phone

- An access phone is located on first floor by the west entrance.

Water Fountains

- Accessible water fountains located throughout the building.

18. Counseling Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Use the main entrance of the Health Center and access the Counseling Center via elevator, PAD.

Elevator

- There is a key-operated elevator that connects the health center to the counseling center.
- For elevator key, contact the Business Office of the Health Center

Accessible Bathrooms

- The nearest accessible bathroom is on the first floor in the Health Center

Parking

- U lot has 11 spaces

18. Hammond Health Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Main entrance, south side of building, PAD

Elevator

- Provides access to first floor and counseling center (on ground floor)

Contact Person/ Hours of Operation

- Regular business hours: 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m., Monday- Friday
- Emergency care available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- For elevator key, contact the business office of the health center

Access Phone

- Located by main entrance

Accessible Bathrooms

- Most accessible men's and women's bathrooms are located on the first floor

Parking

- U lot has 11 spaces

Water Fountain

- An accessible water cooler is located in the waiting area

10, 25, 26. Campus Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor north, near U lot, PAD
- First floor east, near Campus Center Dining Hall, PAD
- Second floor southwest, near free speech rock area, PAD

Elevator

- Located in north and south areas of Campus Center, they provide access to all floors

Access Phone

- Accessible phones located throughout Campus Center

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located on first and second floors

AT/ ALD

- Emerson Suites equipped with FM systems

Parking

- U lot with 11 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains are located on the first and second floors

17. Library**Accessible Entrance/ Exit**

- South Entrance, PAD
- North entrance: enter through Gannett and use the elevator to access the library. Ask the front desk for the key to operate the elevator. PAD

Elevator

- Provides access to the second, third, fourth, and fifth floors
- Ask the front desk for the key to operate the elevator down to the first floor

Access Phone

- Located by south entrance

Accessible Bathrooms

- Most accessible women's bathroom located on second floor
- Most accessible men's bathroom located on third floor

Contact Information

- Elevator key can be retrieved from front desk in library or main desk in Gannett to access the first floor.

Parking

- H lot with 4 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains located on second, third, and fourth floors

General Information

- There is an elevator at the west end of the library on the third floor that connects to the fourth floor of Whalen.

32. Whalen Center for Music**Accessible Entrance/ Exit**

- First floor north, PAD
- Third floor west, PAD
- Fourth floor south (through Baker Walkway), PAD
- There is an east entrance into the 4th floor of Whalen via an elevator that connects to the 3rd floor of the library.

Elevator

- Located at north and south ends of the building, they provide access to all floors.
- Elevator in the far south end provides access to Baker Walkway and to the J Lot

Access Phone

- Access phone on third floor by the music office in a cove, as well as in the Baker Hallway on P level

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located on fourth floor

AT/ ALD

- The Hockett Family Recital Hall is equipped with an FM system
- Ford Hall is equipped with an infrared (IR) system
- There is an FM system throughout the building

Parking

- G lot with 2 spaces
- J lot with 10 spaces (Access building through Baker Walkway)

Water Fountain

- Located in various places throughout the building

General Information

- An elevator located past the bathrooms on the fourth floor connects to the third floor or the library

28. Smiddy Hall

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor east, PAD
- Second floor west, PAD

Elevator

- Located centrally in the building, it provides access to all floors

Access Phone

- Located on second floor near west entrance

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible bathrooms located on each floor

Parking

- F lot (west side of building) with 8 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains are located on the first, second, and third floors

7. Ceracche Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Main entrance, north, PAD

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located on first floor

Parking

- K lot has 1 space

23. Park Hall; Roy H. Park School of Communications

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor north, near O lot, PAD
- Second floor south, PAD

Elevator

- Located in west area of building, it provides access to all floors.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Located on all floors

AT/ ALD

- Park Auditorium is equipped with an FM system

Parking

- O lot with 14 spaces

Water Fountain

- Located on first and second floors

1. Alumni Hall

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Main entrance, south side near parking lot, PAD

Elevator

- Provides access to first and second floors

Accessible Bathrooms

- Two accessible unisex bathrooms located centrally

Hours of Operation

- Business hours 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Parking

- Alumni Hall Parking with 1 space

5. Center for Natural Sciences

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor east (next to Park School), PAD
- Second floor east via ramp, PAD
- Second floor west via ramp, PAD

Elevator

- Located in southwest corner of building, it provides access to all floors

Access Phone

- Located throughout building

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible bathroom located on each floor in the center hallway between the west and east entrances

Parking

- U lot with 11 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains located throughout the building

4. Center for Health Sciences

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor north, PAD
- Second floor north, PAD
- Second floor west, PAD (near F lot drop off circle)

Elevator

- Located approximately 250 ft. from west entrance, it provides access to all floors

Access Phone

- First floor, near computer lab
- Second floor, near west entrance
- Third floor, near doorway that connects CHS and Smiddy

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible bathrooms located on each floor

Parking

- F lot with 8 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains located throughout building

14. Fitness Center**Accessible Entrance/ Exit**

- Main entrance, west side, PAD

Elevator

- Provides access to all floors and is centrally located

Accessible Bathrooms

- Accessible men's and women's bathrooms are located on the first floor and in the locker rooms on the bottom floor
- An accessible shower stall is located in the locker rooms with grab-bars, handheld shower unit, and shower seat

Contact Person/ Hours of Operation

- Regular semester hours: Monday-Thursday 7:00 a.m.- 11:00 a.m., Friday 7:00 a.m.- 8:00 p.m., Saturday 10:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., Sunday 11:00 a.m.- 11:00 p.m.
- Hours vary for holidays and breaks; contact front desk (607 274 3399)

- B lot with 2 spaces

Water Fountain

- Accessible water fountains located throughout building

DH3. Terrace Dining Hall**Accessible Entrance/ Exit**

- Southwest side of building, near T lot

Accessible Bathrooms

- Currently, there are no accessible bathrooms in the Terrace Dining Hall.

Parking

- T lot with 1 space
- U lot with 11 spaces

27. Rothschild Place**Accessible Entrance/ Exit**

- First floor, ramp facing east, PAD

Accessible Bathrooms

- First floor, centrally located

Parking

- U lot with 11 spaces

- O lot with 14 spaces
- Adjacent to building with 2 spaces

Water Fountain

- A water cooler is located in the main office of the Academic Advising Center.

2. Athletics and Events Center (Glazer Arena, Aquatics Pavilion

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor east, by the drop off area, PAD
- Second floor, southwest entrance and southeast entrance, PAD

Elevator

- Centrally located, access to all floors

Accessible Bathrooms

- First floor, south entrance
- Second floor, southeast entrance

Parking

- M lot with 6 spaces

Water Fountain

- Throughout building

Extra Note

- The Glazer Arena entrance is not PAD

9. Dillingham Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Two entrances on north ground floor (G)
- South first floor (LL), accessible ramp

Elevator

- North and South elevators, access to all floors

Accessible Bathrooms

- Mezzanine level (ML) which is unisex

Parking

- Lot F with 8 spaces
- Lot P with 3 spaces

Water Fountain

- Throughout the building

3. Center for Business and Sustainable Enterprise, Dorothy D. and Roy H. Park

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor south via walkway from Job Hall, PAD
- First floor west, PAD
- First floor east, PAD
- Second floor south over walkway, PAD

Elevator

- North and south elevators, access to all floors

Accessible Bathrooms

- First floor centrally located

- Second floor East

Parking

- E lot with 20 spaces

Water Fountain

- Throughout building

15. Ford Observatory

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- North

Accessible Bathrooms

- Southeast

Parking

- E lot with 20 spaces

19. Hill Center

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor west, PAD
- Second floor east, PAD

Elevator

- Centrally located

Accessible Bathrooms

- First floor centrally located and within locker rooms

Parking

- G lot with 2 spaces

Water Fountain

- Throughout building

24. Peggy Ryan Williams Center (Office of Admissions)

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- Garden Level: The accessible entrance/exit is located to the right of the main entrance, far back of the building (north of the main entrance), PAD
- First Floor: Front of the building at the main entrance (off P Lot Admissions parking), PAD

Elevator

- Garden Level: Enter the building, make a right around the staircase
- First Floor:
 - Left of the main entrance, make your first left past the main entrance.
 - Facing the back accessible entrance, make a right, a second right, which brings you to the accessible elevator.

Accessible Bathrooms

- Garden level: Facing the back accessible entrance, make a right, a second right, which brings you to the Restrooms (next to the accessible elevator)
- First floor: Across from the accessible elevator

Parking

- P lot with 3 spaces

Water Fountain

- Throughout building

6. Center for Public Safety and General Services

Accessible Entrance/ Exit

- First floor, northwest, PAD
- Second floor, south, PAD

Elevator

- First floor, southwest
- Second floor, southwest

Accessible Bathrooms

- First floor south
- Four restrooms on the second floor

Parking

- 2 spaces

Water Fountain

- To the right of the main entrance on the second floor

30. Towers Concourse

Accessible Entrance

- East and west tower ends of the main hallways, PAD

Elevators

- In either Tower

Accessible Bathrooms

- Next to restrooms entrance in the middle of the main hallway

Parking

- J lot with 10 spaces
