Please allow enough time so that your shipments arrive here no later than 10:00 AM on Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup>. Due to our central receiving procedures, shipments received later than that will NOT make it to the show floor on time. You are responsible for arranging for the breakdown and removal of all material from the show floor and Ithaca College. We do not have room to store large pallets or boxes that items are shipped in. Removal from campus must be completed no later than 5:00 PM on Thursday, March 26th, the day of the show. If you need to ship any items AFTER the event, you MUST have pre-printed shipping labels or bills of lading. 
