TOP 8 CAREER COMPETENCIES THAT TODAY'S EMPLOYERS WANT...

AND THAT YOUR COURSE MAY PROVIDE!

Communication

Clearly and effectively exchange information, ideas, facts, and perspectives with persons inside and outside of an organization.



Critical Thinking

Identify and respond to needs based upon an understanding of situational context and logical analysis of relevant information.



Professionalism

Knowing work environments differ greatly, understand and demonstrate effective work habits, and act in the interest of the larger community and workplace.



Equity and Inclusion

Demonstrate the awareness, attitude, knowledge, and skills required to equitably engage and include people from different cultures and backgrounds.



Leadership

Recognize and capitalize on personal and team strengths to achieve organizational goals.



Teamwork

Build and maintain collaborative relationships to work effectively toward common goals, while appreciating diverse viewpoints and shared responsibilities.



Career & Self-Development

Proactively develop oneself and one's career through continual personal and professional learning, awareness of one's strengths and weaknesses, navigation of career opportunities, and networking.



Technology

Understand and leverage technologies ethically to enhance efficiencies, complete tasks, and accomplish goals.



*These competencies can be highlighted in your syllabus or assignments to articulate how your course is helping to prepare students for their career, regardless of what that may be.
