

# S/D/F INFORMATION

## WHAT IS AN S/D/F?

- S/D/F stands for **Satisfactory/D Grade/Fail**, and is an option to encourage exploration and experimentation in curricular areas in which you may have had little or no previous experience.
- Any course for a major or minor must be taken for a letter grade (unless otherwise noted as a pass/fail course).
- If you are registered for S/D/F and earn a grade below C-, that grade (D+, D, D-, or F) will be calculated into your GPA.

## HOW?

- You must complete an **S/D/F option form on IC workflow**.
- The S/D/F option can be used up to **four times** in your bachelor's degree program, **only one S/D/F course is allowed per semester**.

## WHEN?

- If you choose the S/D/F option and would like to rescind the choice and opt for a grade, you can do so **before the end of week 10**.
- You must submit the **S/D/F option form by the end of week 10** in the semester (withdraw day) to earn course credit, but not the grade.
