Academic Regalia

The custom of wearing academic caps and gowns is traced to the 12th century when most people wore long, flowing robes. By the 17th century, certain universities established the tradition of wearing apparel that distinguished different degrees and faculties. In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission developed a code that regulated the design of gowns and hoods and their colors.

TIM REYNOLDS is an assistant professor of exercise science and athletic training in the School of Health Sciences and Human Performance who also earned his undergraduate and graduate degrees from IC. He now teaches courses in anatomy and physiology and is a part-time outpatient orthopedic physical therapist

with Cayuga Medical Center. His current research interests include the impact of communication in patient outcomes and gamification in the classroom.

Reynolds has explored the use of social media to enhance student learning through his professional social media platforms (TikTok: @anp_professor and Instagram: @anatomy_professor), which provide engaging anatomy and medical content to over a million followers.

In 2021, Reynolds coauthored the book *Movers & Mentors: Leaders in Movement Science Share Tips, Tactics, and Stories*, a compilation of personal and professional guidance for rehabilitation professionals contributed by more than 75 leaders in the fields of physical therapy and movement science. He has also published on the significance of word choice with patients, incorporating social media within the classroom, and multiple patient case reports.

While an undergraduate, Reynolds played on IC's baseball team and is now the team's faculty athletic mentor. As a graduate student, he ventured into entrepreneurship. The idea for his company, KettleShell, began when he figured out a way to transform a standard dumbbell into a kettlebell. With the help of his business partner and two faculty members, the idea for KettleShell won the Ithaca College Business Plan Competition as well as the New York State Business Plan Competition.

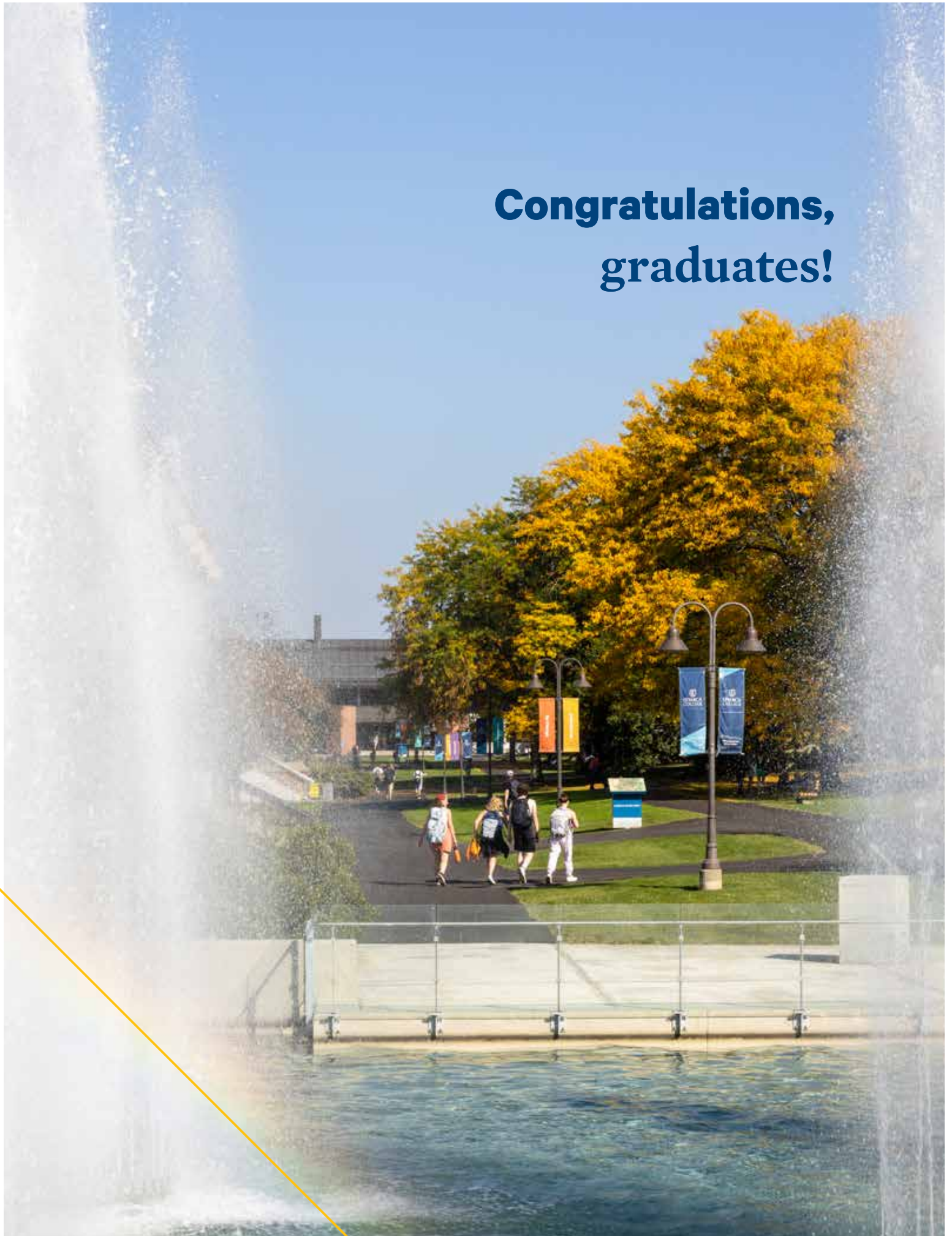
MEDALLION
